What can we predict?



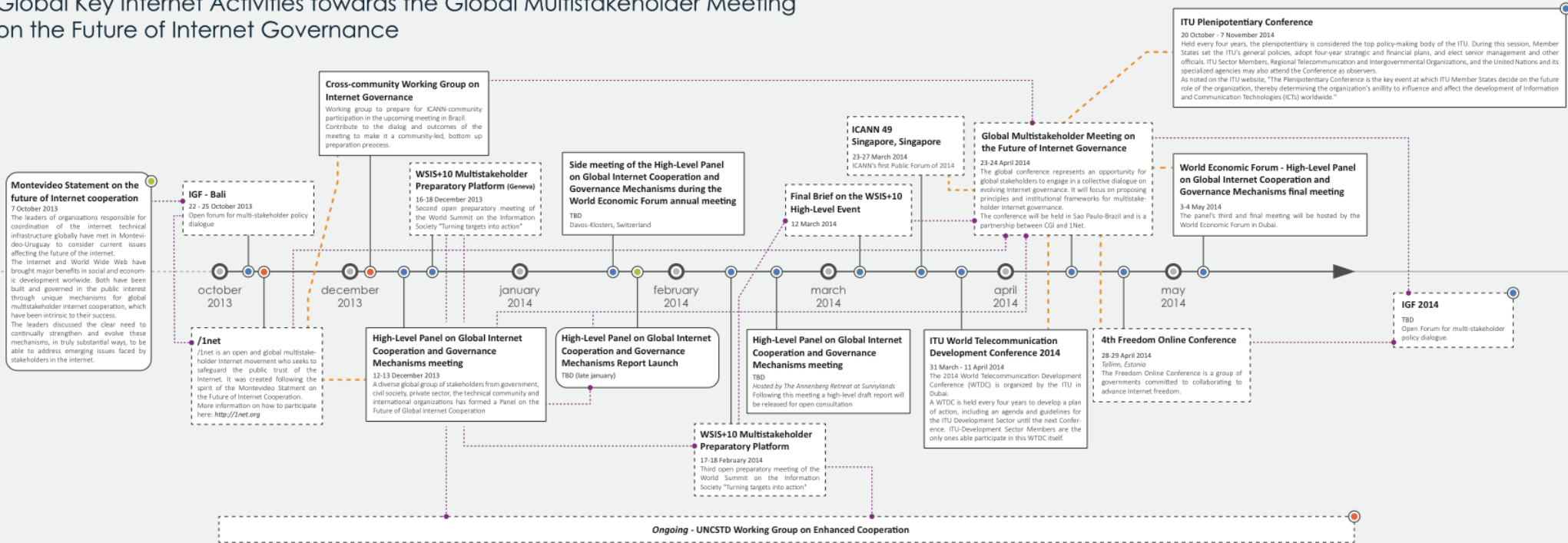
There are **known knowns**; there are things we know we know.

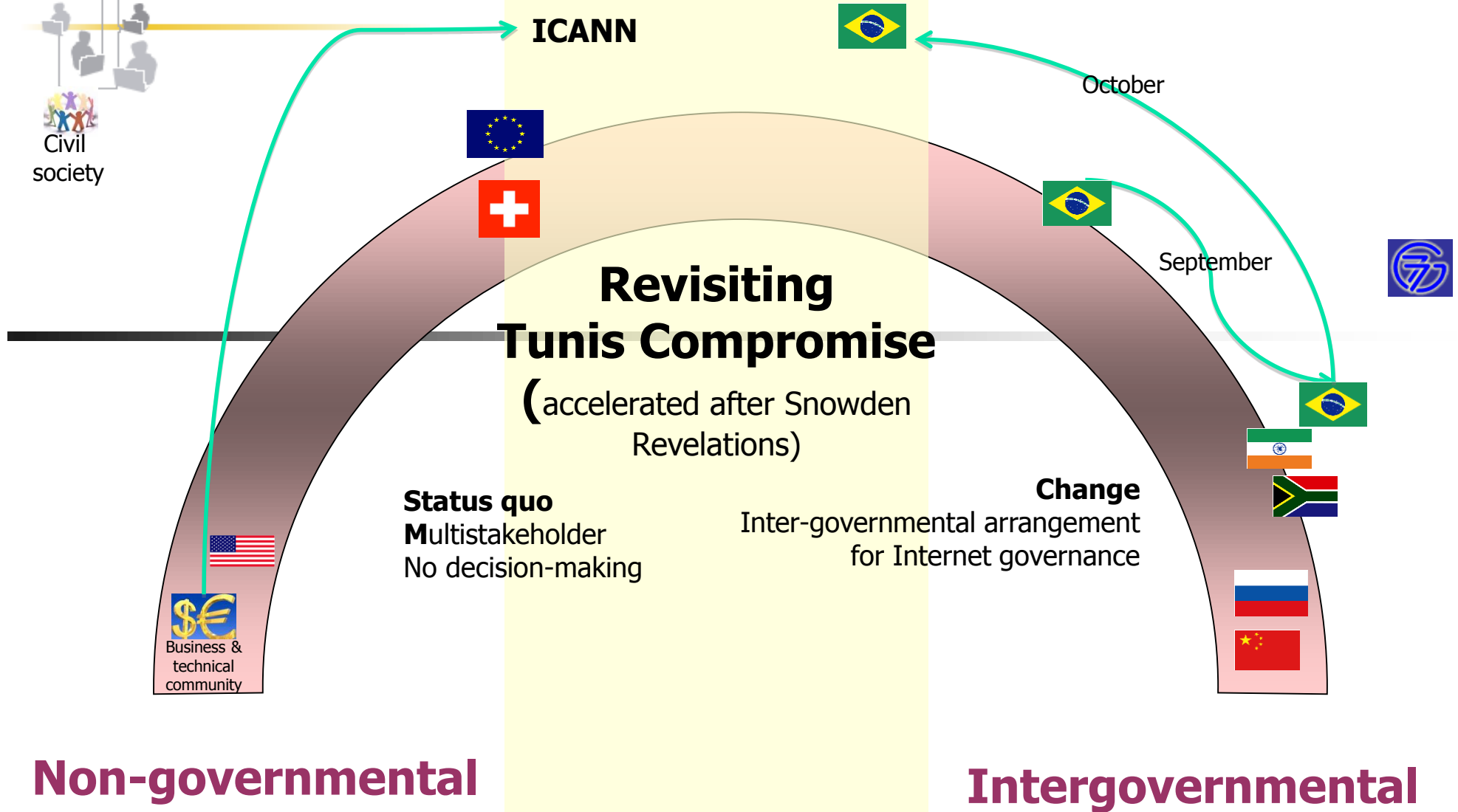

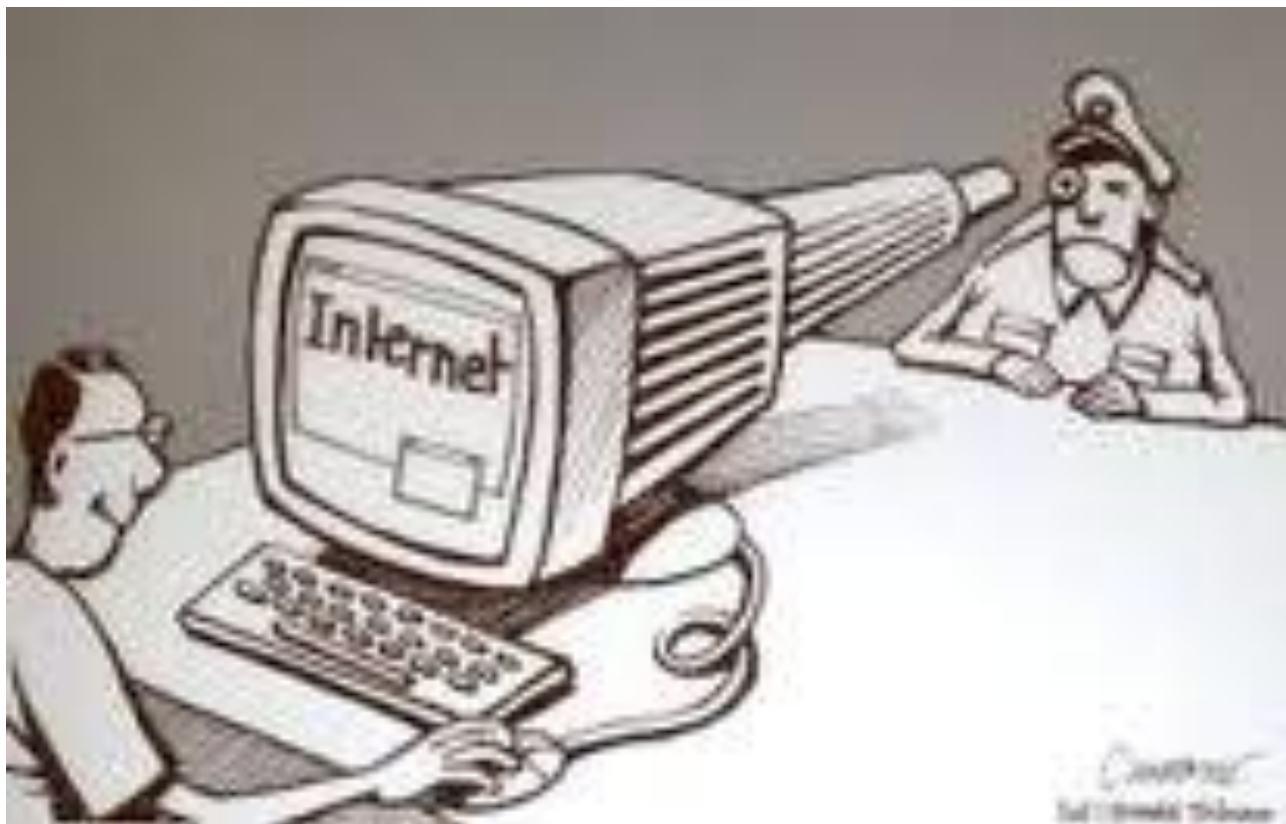

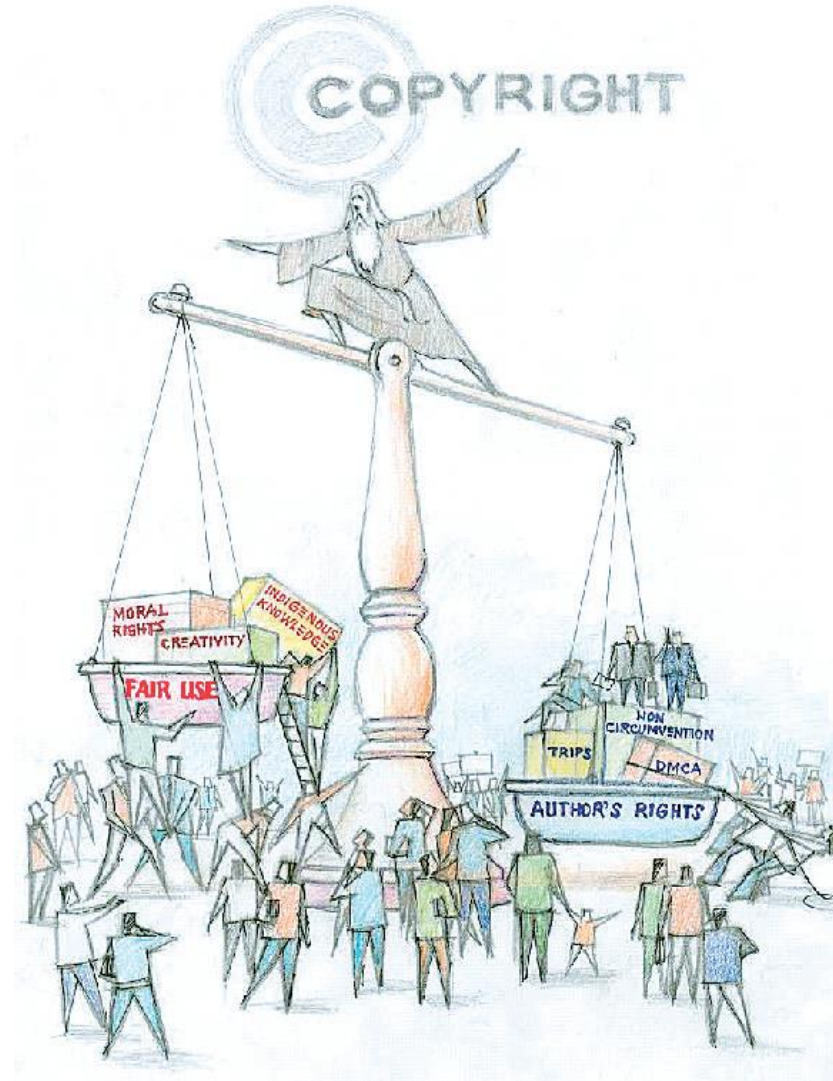
